


The home was built in the 1950's as a ranch bungalow, then remodeled during the 1990's in McKellar Park. There were issues with some of the work done by others, but we addressed that during our reconstruction.

The home owners approached us at the Ottawa Home Show to help them with a new design and layout, and then build - they were tired of living with the outdated everything and wanted a complete upgrade to their standards. We hit it off immediately - it was a good fit.

We worked with a local architect who draws by hand, my Cuban friend who is a talented graphics designer who created the 3D renderings based on John's drawings, a kitchen designer and their group, and of course the building of the project by our excellent trade partners and in-house team.

We started the project on January 18 2021 and were substantially completed by May 21, 2021. Our clients and their two kids lived in our 5 star Airbnb during the course of the project, taking a major stressor out of the equation.
